The Charter Revision Committee is an appointed citizen/City Council body with the primary responsibility of providing recommendations to the Mayor and City Council in revising the City Charter and presenting that newly revised document to the voters of Shady Cove for approval.

As the City Charter is the “Law of the Land”, it is the document from which all other laws and operations spring forth.

The committee will meet until the work is completed and suggestions have been accepted by the City Council to be forwarded to the citizens in a General Election.

The first meeting will begin soon.

Applicant must have lived within Shady Cove City limits for at least the last 12 months and be a registered voter in the State of Oregon.
