### **CITY COUNCIL MEETING: SEPTEMBER 4, 2014**

The Council had the second reading and approved Ordinance 268. Simply stated the ordinance authorizes the imposition of a 5% tax on the sale of medicinal marijuana and 10% on the sale of recreational marijuana.

Legalization of the sale and use of recreational marijuana is on the November 4th ballot. Included in the ballot measure language is a prohibition to implement relevant taxes. However, if taxes are approved prior to November 4th, they may remain in place.

Impact of the legalized sale of marijuana, on public safety personnel, is unknown. This ordinance is intended to provide additional public safety resources, if such a need arises.

A moratorium on the sale of medicinal marijuana, in the City of Shady Cove, remains in place until the end of April 2015.

The Council also had the first reading of Ordinance 269. This ordinance amends the City's Sign Regulations.

### **CITY COUNCIL MEETING: SEPTEMBER 18, 2014**

The Council had the second reading of approved Ordinance 269 which amended the Sign Regulations. The amendments were developed over several months by the City's Planning Commission, with considerable public input.



### **LEAF PICK UP: OCTOBER 22, 2014 THRU FEBRUARY 2015**

Fall is here and with that the leaves begin to drop. The City of Shady Cove is trying something new this year to help keep the leaves out of the streets, ditches, and off our lawns.
