CITY NEWS

The City Council has addressed many important issues this year including a reevaluation of the System Development Charges resulting in reduced fees; the City's Fee Schedule undergoing a remake resulting in a consolidation of and in many cases a reduction of fees; Evaluation of Vacation Rentals in Residential Zones, following a lengthy trial resulting in a change in the Zoning Ordinance wherein Vacation Rentals are now conditionally permitted in Residential Zones and a myriad of marijuana related matters.

Additional important matters are on the horizon, including marijuana related issues, the States demand that we address the riparian issue and an update of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

However, in September we experienced a lull. The meeting scheduled for the 17th was cancelled. During the meeting on the 3rd, following a presentation from the Army Corps of Engineers regarding inundation related to a failure of the dam at Lost Creek Lake (noted highly unlikely), the Council addressed a couple of house keeping items.

One very positive action did take place. City Administrator, Aaron Prunty was presented with a Certificate of Competition of the League of Oregon Cities program titled "Local Government Management". The program was

established about 7 years ago. Aaron enrolled in December 2011 and successfully completed the program August 2015. The program consists of 44 courses/subjects in 10 major categories. Those categories are:

1. Budget & Finance
2. Human Resources and Management
3. Public Safety & Emergency Management Services
4. Public Works and Utilities
5. Land Use & Economic Development
6. Public Contracting & Purchasing
7. Community Relations
8. Risk Management
9. Councilor/Manager Competencies
10. Ethics & Leadership
